HIKES, BIKES & SIGHTS

Campers will engage in adventures including Nature Hikes, Mountain Biking, and Sightseeing/Orienteering. Campers will learn a wide variety of outdoor skills from Orienteering, Wilderness Survival, and Nature Awareness. Campers will bring their own bikes from home to enjoy bumps, jumps and trails at camp. This camp also gives the campers an opportunity to use what they learn with a one day off site trip to a local park.

Our low ropes course offers over 15 different elements to challenge campers leading up to scale our 35' Dual Face, Rock Climbing Tower.

### MAD SCIENCE

#### **Space: The Final Frontier (Week 1)**

Throughout the week, campers will explore the mysteries of space from an astronaut's point of view! Children will learn about how space explorers embark on a journey throughout the atmosphere and experience "a week in the life" of an astronaut as they explore space and report back to the scientists on planet Earth. Aspiring astronauts will study gravity, propulsion, and the basics of rocket science as they are guided through hands-on experiments and demonstrations. Junior Mad Scientists will explore the aerodynamic properties of flying machines by building their own Estes model rocket and prepare for a Mad Science space mission of a grand finale rocket launch!

#### **Radical Reactions & Detective Science (Week 5)**

Mad Science brings awe-inspiring experiments and thought-evoking detective work to campers as they further their fascination with science. Children will learn about chemical reactions as they grow crystals, create sidewalk chalk from scratch, and design chromatography t-shirts to take home. Campers become trained science sleuths as they investigate the role of chemistry at the scene of a crime and practice making thorough observations as they dust for fingerprints.
